1. <u>RFP Objective</u>

EMW Gas Association ("EMW Gas") is seeking a single, qualified Non-Destructive Testing service provider to provide NDT testing of new natural gas pipeline installed as part of the EMW 2017 Expansion Project. EMW will review proposals and enter into negotiations with the vendor whose proposal is most advantageous to EMW with price and other factors considered.

Following negotiation, the successful proposer will be asked to enter into a contract with EMW. The length of that contract is proposed to be the duration of this project which is projected to end before January 31, 2018.

EMW Gas is using a competitive negotiation process to award a contract to the successful proposer. Although cost is a significant criterion for selection, EMW will award based upon a number of criteria evaluated as described by this RFP.

2. Company Introduction

Founded in 1964 by Joint Powers Agreement between the Town of Estancia, City of Moriarty and Village of Willard, EMW Gas is a Local Public Body distributing natural gas to approximately 5000 consumers in the Estancia Valley. EMW employs approximately 20 employees and is located in Estancia, New Mexico with a small field office in Moriarty. EMW is required by law to comply with the NM Procurement Code NMSA 1978 Article 1 Section 13-1-1 through 13-1-199 as amended.

3. Project Scope of Work

The successful proposer will have experience and knowledge suitable to perform NDT with Radiographic Inspection for the entire EMW 2017 Expansion Construction Project, which is scheduled to begin October 10, 2017. NDT testing is scheduled to begin on or around October 30, 2017 and is expected to be completed before January 31, 2018.

Project is installation of four (4) miles of six-inch 0.188-inch wall X-52 pipe with two regulator stations. 100% X-Ray will be performed. Note the estimated following Engineer's weld estimates:

4. <u>Proposal Submission</u>

6. Service Requirements

Approximately 4,800 feet of the project will require a four-wheel drive truck to access the pipeline.

7. <u>Company Requirements</u>

All prospective sub-contractors (if any) must be disclosed in the proposal.

Proposer and his sub-contractor(s) must possess any licenses or registrations required to do business in the State of New Mexico. Awarded proposer must present a completed IRS W-9 form when requested upon award. Awarded proposer and his sub-contractor(s) must comply with all Federal, State and Local rules and regulations.

C. Level of Service

Proposal should describe service levels to be provided in that crew must be available when needed by the inspector. The inspector will give adequate notice of date, time and location of NDT services needed.

- F. Evaluation Factors: Responses shall be reviewed on these critical factors and will be weighted as follows:

Additional Optional Points: Five additional points will be added to proposals containing a NM Resident Certificate OR ten additional points will be added to proposals containing a NM Resident Veteran Certificate. Total points with an optional preference added will yield a maximum of 110 points.

G. Resident or Veteran Resident Preferences

Proposers who maintains a principle place of business in New Mexico and who desires EMW to apply either of these preferences must submit a **RESIDENT** or **RESIDENT VETERAN CERTIFICATE** (issued by the New Mexico Taxation and Revenue Department) with their proposal in order to receive a 5% (Resident) or a 10% (Resident Veteran) Preference during the evaluation process. The fifteen (15) day protest period for responsive Proposers shall begin on the day following the Contract award and will end as of Close of Business Mountain Time 15 days after the Contract Award. Protests must be written and must include the name and address of the protestor and the Request for Proposals number. It must also contain a statement of grounds for protest including appropriate supporting exhibits, and it must specify the ruling requested from the State Purchasing Agent. The protest must be delivered to the EMW Chief Procurement Officer as indicated in # below. **Protests received after the deadline will not be accepted.**
